After a period in Persia at Schamake, he was suspended alleged technical irregularities, including the confirmation 604 candidates in Holland at the request of the Church in Amsterdam. The Dutch Church had been without a Bishop for 18 years as a punishment from Rome because the Dutch Church refused to co-operate in the persecution of the "Jansenists" in Holland.

⁶ Elected Seventh Archbishop of Utrecht, the Primateal See of Holland and canonical successor to Saint Willibord, the English missionary who brought the faith to Holland. In this consecration was born the Old Catholic Church.
